

Your 46er Contributions at Work -- 2022 Yearly Report: [5-3-23]

During 2022 the 46er Board contributed **\$ 73,906** to various agencies, individuals, and programs. This was financed by **member donations of \$93,195**. Those of you who send a few extra dollars with your regular dues make funding these programs possible. Thanks to your generosity the Executive Board was able to fund the following projects:

- \$ 6,000 For ADK's Pro Trail crew to complete a pre-season trail sweep and blowdown removal.
 - \$ 20,000 For Avalanche Pass trail work by ADK Pro Crew.
 - \$ 15,000. For Phelps trail work by ADK Pro Crew.
 - \$ 25,000 For the Summit Steward Program budget.
 - \$ 1,450. Train two Leave No Trace Instructors.
 - \$ 500. To the 507 Fund to create an endowment for the Summit Steward Program.
 - \$ 1,500. To Lean2 Rescue for logs to replace lean-tos within the high peaks.
 - \$ 2,340. Ausable River Association to rent porta-johns at trailheads.
 - \$ 1,750. Send two students to the DEC Conservation Camp.
